

## Individual Training Sessions:

Every morning each camper will be apart of specialized training sessions designed to improve each camper's ability with the ball in the fundamentals of the sport. These sessions will cover passing, dribbling, finishing, defending, and group tactics.

## Camp Competitions:

## Directions to Brewton-Parker

### Going I-16 East:

Take the I-16 Exit 58 to Hwy 199. Turn right at the stop sign where 199 will dead into 221/15. At US 221/15 turn right. Turn left at Stop light in Mount Vernon, Georgia onto Hwy 280. One mile form the light make a left onto S. Johnson St. Then turn right at Snooks Activity Center.

### Going I-16 West:

Take the I-16 Exit 78 and turn left onto Hwy 221 to Soperton, GA. Follow Hwy 221 through Soperton to Mount Vernon. In Mount Vernon turn left at the stop light which is Hwy 280. One mile from the stop light turn left onto S. Johnson St. Turn right at the Snooks Activity Center.

### From Jacksonville, Florida:

Take Interstate 295 to Hwy 1 North. Go north through Waycross to Lyons, Georgia. Turn left onto Hwy 280 in Lyons. Continue onto Hwy 280 West into Mount Vernon. Brewton-Parker will be on the right. Take a right onto S. Johnson St. Turn right at the Snooks Activity Center.

### From Valdosta, Georgia:

Take Hwy 221 to Uvalda, Georgia. Turn left in Uvalda (will still be on Hwy 221) toward Mount Vernon. Turn right onto Hwy 280 in Mount Vernon at the stop light. One mile from the light take a left onto S. Jackson St. Turn right at the Snooks Activity Center.
