**2008 Filing Requirements for Most Taxpayers**

IF your filing status is...	AND at the end of 2007 you were...*	THEN file a return if your gross income was at least...**
Single	Under 65	\$8,950
	65 or older	\$10,300
Married filing jointly***	Under 65 (both spouses)	\$17,900
	65 or older (one spouse)	\$18,950
	65 or older (both spouses)	\$20,000
Married filing separately	Any age	\$3,500
Head of Household	Under 65	\$11,500
	65 or older	\$12,850
Qualifying widow(er) with dependent child	Under 65	\$14,400
	65 or older	\$15,450

\* If you were born on January 1, 1941, you are considered to be age 65 at the end of 2008.

\*\* Gross income means all income you received in the form of money, goods, property, and services that is not exempt from tax, including any income from sources outside the US (even if you may exclude part or all of it). **Do not** include social security benefits as gross income unless you are married filing a separate return and you lived with your spouse at any time during 2008.

\*\*\* If you did not live with your spouse at the end of 2008 (or on the date your spouse died) and your gross income was at least \$3,500, you must file a return regardless of your age
