Transient Student Application and Instructions 2009-2010

Transient students are eligible for the following financial aid assistance at Brewton-Parker College:

- **STATE FUNDING**

1. **HOPE Scholarship:** Available to students enrolled in 6+ credit hours per semester and HOPE eligibility has been determined by parent college. **HOPE Transient Letter Required.**
 - Full-time (12+ hrs) HOPE Scholarship at BPC is \$1750 per semester.
 - Less than full-time (6 to 11 hrs) HOPE Scholarship at BPC is \$875 per semester.
2. **Georgia Tuition Equalization Grant:** Available to students enrolled in 12 credit hours per semester and a Georgia state resident. The Grant is \$550 per semester. **GTEG Application Required.**

- **INSTITUTIONAL FUNDING**

1. **BPG External Grant:** Available to students classified as a External Students. The grant is equal to \$137 per semester hour to a maximum of \$2055 per semester.
2. **Institutional Equalization Grant:** Available to students enrolled in 12 or more credit hours per semester. Grant is \$1000 per semester. This grant is not available to HOPE Scholarship recipients.

All Transient students wishing any of the above scholarships must complete the TRANSIENT STUDENT APPLICATION.

NO TITLE IV FEDERAL STUDENT AID IS AVAILABLE TO TRANSIENT STUDENTS. TITLE IV FEDERAL STUDENT AID IS: PELL GRANT, SEOG, FEDERAL WORK-STUDY, STAFFORD AND PERKINS LOANS.

BAPTIST MEMBERSHIP FUNDS ARE NOT AVAILABLE TO TRANSIENT STUDENTS.

Students wishing to received Federal Student Aid must be admitted to BPC as a degree seeking student and complete the financial aid process. The financial aid process at BPC includes completion of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid, and other forms. Contact the Financial Aid Office for forms and instructions.

Students not wishing to be BPC degree candidates, but wanting federal student aid may complete a CONSORTIUM AGREEMENT with their parent college. The Parent College will then process and pay financial aid to the student. Students may contact the Financial Aid Office of their parent college for forms and instructions.

Transient students will not receive sufficient aid to pay all BPC tuition and fees. Transient students **must** pay costs not covered by grants and scholarships.
