**2010 Filing Requirements for Most Taxpayers**

<b>IF your filings status is...</b>	<b>AND at the end of 2010 you were...*</b>	<b>THEN file a return if your gross income was at least...**</b>
Single	Under 65	\$9,350
	65 or older	\$10,750
Married filed jointly***	Under 65 (both spouses)	\$18,700
	65 or older (one spouse)	\$19,800
	65 or older (both spouses)	\$20,900
Married filed separately	Any age	\$3,650
Head of Household	Under 65	\$12,000
	65 or older	13,400
Qualifying widow(er) with dependent child	Under 65	\$15,050
	65 or older	\$16,150

\* If you were born on January 1, 1942, you are considered to be age 65 at the end of 2010.

\*\* Gross income means all income you receive in the form, goods, property, and services that is not exempt from tax, including any income from sources outside the US (even if you may exclude part or all of it). **Do not** include social security benefits as gross income unless you are married filing a separate return and you lived with your spouse at any time during 2010.

\*\*\* If you did not live with your spouse at the end of 2010 (or on that date your spouse died) and your gross income was at least \$3,650, must file a return regardless of your age.
