Transient Student Application and Instructions **(For student taking classes at Brewton Parker)** **2011-2012**

Transient students are eligible for the following financial aid assistance at Brewton-Parker College:

STATE FUNDING

1. **HOPE Scholarship:** Available to students enrolled in 6+ credit hours per semester and HOPE eligibility has been determined by host college. **HOPE Transient Letter Required.**

- Full-time (12+ hrs) HOPE Scholarship at BPC is \$2000 per semester.
- Less than full-time (6 to 11 hrs) HOPE Scholarship at BPC is \$1000 per semester.

2. **Georgia Tuition Equalization Grant:** Available to students enrolled in 12 credit hours per semester and a Georgia state resident. The Grant is \$375 per semester. **GTEG Application Required.**

INSTITUTIONAL FUNDING – There are no institutional funds available for Transient students.

All Transient students wishing any of the above scholarships must complete the **TRANSIENT STUDENT APPLICATION.**

NO TITLE IV FEDERAL STUDENT AID IS AVAILABLE TO TRANSIENT STUDENTS. TITLE IV FEDERAL STUDENT AID IS: PELL GRANT, SEOG, FEDERAL WORK-STUDY, STAFFORD AND PERKINS LOANS.

BAPTIST MEMBERSHIP FUNDS ARE NOT AVAILABLE TO TRANSIENT STUDENTS.

Students wishing to receive Federal Student Aid must be admitted to BPC as a degree seeking student and complete the financial aid process. The financial aid process at BPC includes completion of the Free Application for Federal Student Aid, and other forms. Contact the Financial Aid Office for forms and instructions.

Students not wishing to be BPC degree candidates, but wanting federal student aid may complete a **CONSORTIUM AGREEMENT** with their parent college. The Parent College will then process and pay financial aid to the student. Students may contact the Financial Aid Office of their parent college for forms and instructions.

Transient students will not receive sufficient aid to pay all BPC tuition and fees.

Transient students **must pay** costs not covered by grants and scholarships.
