The college is proud to again host the Georgia Baptist Convention's Youth I and Youth II Music camps on campus June 6-13. The Youth I is for students grades seven to eight, and the Youth II is for students grades nine to college freshman. Several BPC faculty and staff are key to the success of the camps as instructors and volunteer coordinators.



Other notable camps on campus this summer will be the Daniell Baptist Association's camp for grades six to 12 July 7-12, and the Fellowship of Christian Athlete's Passing Camp sponsored and started by BPC alum and current GBC President, Rev.
