

BPC CHILI COOK-OFF

Brewton-Parker College's Fourth Annual Chili Cook-off will be held **Saturday, October 22, 2011 between the hours of 11 a.m. and 2 p.m.** on the Mount Vernon campus on the banks of Jones Lake behind the Phillips Student Center.

We would like to invite you and/or your team to participate as a Chili Cooker. This is a wonderful opportunity to participate in this fun community event. Now is the time to put this event on your calendar. Registration fee is \$25 per entry. Additional chili may be entered at \$15 each.

The winner of the BPC Chili Cook-off with the People's Choice Award (designated by public voting) will receive the "traveling trophy" and bragging rights for next year.

The following is a brief description and format for the day:

- Chili Cookers should arrive at the Mount Vernon campus' Chili Cook-off area and be set up for business no later than 10:30 a.m.; "doors" open to the public at 11 a.m. Parking is available within walking distance on campus. Unless your vehicle is part of your set up for your chili, it needs to be moved by 10:30. If it is part of the setup, it needs to remain in place until after 2 p.m. for safety.
- Cookers should prepare for approximately 8-10 gallons of chili (serving cups and spoons will be provided). Cookers will be responsible for their own equipment. No electricity will be available at the booths. No generators allowed. Propane gas cookers permitted.
- Booth decoration is encouraged. Banners for organization and company promotion are encouraged. Each team is required to have a tent and a table. Teams must provide own tents and tables.
- Judging will begin shortly after the doors open at 11 a.m., with winner announcements beginning at 1:30 p.m. Ballot boxes will be placed at each booth for People's Choice Award. Celebrity Judges will be provided a sample from each competitor (anonymous) for first, second and third place prizes. Judging categories include: Best Tasting Chili, Most Unique and Best Vegetarian. Prizes will be awarded during the final ceremony.
- Live Entertainment featured throughout the competition.

In order for us to better plan the event, we ask that you respond with your completed, signed registration form (below) and registration fee as soon as possible and **no later than October 12, 2011.**
