# BPC CHILI COOK-OFF

Brewton-Parker College's first Chili Cook-off will be held **Saturday, October 24, 2009 between the hours of 11 a.m. and 3 p.m.** on the Mount Vernon campus on the banks of Jones Lake behind the Phillips Student Center.

We would like to invite you and/or your team to participate as a Chili Cooker. This is a wonderful opportunity to participate in this fun community event. Now is the time to put this event on your calendar. Registration fee is \$25 per entry—whether individual or team. The winner of the BPC Chili Cook-off will also receive a “traveling trophy” along with bragging rights for next year.

The following is a brief description and format for the day:

- Chili Cookers should arrive at the Mount Vernon campus' Chili Cook-off area and be set up for business no later than 10:30 a.m.; “doors” open to the public at 11 a.m. Parking is available within walking distance on campus. Unless your vehicle is part of your set up for your chili, it needs to be moved by 10:30. If it is part of the setup, it needs to remain in place until after 3 p.m. for safety.
- Cookers should prepare for approximately 8-10 gallons of chili (serving cups and spoons will be provided). Cookers will be responsible for their own equipment. No electricity will be available at the booths.
- Booth decoration is encouraged. Banners for organization and company promotion are encouraged. Each team is required to have a tent and a table.
- Judging will begin shortly after the doors open at 11 a.m., with prizes announced by 3 p.m. Ballot boxes will be placed at each booth for People's Choice Award. Celebrity Judges will be provided a sample from each competitor (anonymous) for first, second and third place prizes.
