### **What is in a Brewton-Parker Dorm Room?**

- Two twin size beds
- Two closets
- Two desks with chairs
- Two dressers
- Free cable/ wireless internet

### **What you might want to bring:**

- Ethernet cord
- Power strips/surge protectors/extension cord
- Professional outfit ( for church or you may have to dress up more for another occasion)
- Quarters for laundry ( It's a dollar to wash and a dollar to dry)
- Air fresher
- Area/throw rug
- Alarm clock
- Tree style floor lamp/desk lamp/clip-on-lamp
- Laundry stuff ( detergent, dryer sheets, ...)
- Clothes hangers
- Iron/ Mini Ironing board
- Bath towels
- Shower shoes
- Microwave (should not draw more than 750 Watts of power.)
- Mini-Refrigerator
- Camera ( great memories )
- Plastic cups, plates, and utensils
- Trash can
- Umbrella
- Laptop/desktop computer
- Bed linens/blankets/pillows
- School supplies (stapler, paper, hole punch, tape...)
- Toaster
- T.V (screens should not exceed 19inches )
- Cleaning supplies

**Things you don't want to bring/are not permitted:**

- Pets
- Room modifications (nails, paint, wallpaper, tapes that leave residue or damage to walls, etc.)
- Cooking appliances with open burners are not allowed in residence hall rooms, such as hotplates, grills (charcoal or gas).
- No concrete blocks or lofting of beds or loft system allowed in dorm.
