*Any student who has successfully completed 24 hours of college-level classes is exempt from BPC 100. ***Three semesters of Concert Choir (MUS-CC 160/ 260/360/460) fulfills the Fine Arts core requirement.

Students must have a 3.0 cumulative GPA in order to enter the nursing program.

Student must earn a grade of C or higher in all required pre-nursing courses, including those that are part of the single core. Students must earn 67 hours of the pre-nursing curriculum prior to entering 300-level nursing courses. Nursing students may need more than 4 semesters in order to achieve this; therefore, utilizing summer terms is highly recommended.
